In Manitoba no new confirmed Covid 19 cases to report. Still keep social distancing!!!

Other news...Carolyn (Recreation Worker) has worked her last day today...although she was going to stay for the week she really needs to rest before baby comes! So we said good bye today and good luck with the baby!

I realized that I have not formally introduced our two (2) new Recreation staff. Michael Bergen is filling our full-time indefinite term Recreation Worker (non-certified). Michael holds a Bachelor of Kinesiology from the U of M and has spent time working with MiniU, University of Manitoba with children's programs in the capacity of Support Worker. Michael joined GLL on March 16, 2020!

Cathy Ngo is in a full-time indefinite term Recreation Worker (certified). Cathy is a recent graduate of University of Manitoba, Bachelor of Recreation Management and Community Development, and started April 6, 2020.

We are happy to have both Mike and Cathy join the lodge! Both were busy with exercise program with residents today, in small groups. There were some facetime calls and a few family members had window visits. We are trying to keep our facetime calls to ten (10) minutes, so that we can have several a day. Please try and ensure that you be mindful of the times! Thank so much!

Nathan Lo (Rehab Aide) will be adjusting his hours effective tomorrow April 15, 2020, to 1000 – 1800 hours, to support meal time on the second (2nd) floor. This will be on an indefinite basis.

To further elaborate on a concern that a family member brought forward earlier regarding food, snacks, treats being dropped at the lodge by family for staff. The following is the protocol for any food being dropped at the lodge;

1. Packaged food must allow for cleaning/disinfection upon arrival (e.g. plastic container). No cardboard boxes or Styrofoam will be permitted. Food

deliveries should be placed at the entrance and social distancing must be maintained at the hand off.

2. Prior to receipt of delivery, staff must perform hand hygiene.
3. Staff should remove food from outer transport container/warmer/bag (dispose or return to the person as appropriate) AND wipe the exterior transport container with a site-approved disinfectant wipe (every effort must be made to ensure food inside the container is not exposed to the chemicals during the enhanced cleaning protocol).
4. Allow the container to air dry.
5. Perform hand hygiene following cleaning of the container.
6. Move container to an appropriate area for consumption (normal restrictions regarding food and beverage consumption in specific work areas continue to apply).
7. Ensure hand hygiene is performed after serving the meal and prior to eating.

We are going to start working on our window tonight to get it prettied up for visits! We'll be sure to post pics for you all to see!

We hope that you are all keeping well, practicing social distancing and staying close to home. We thank you for your continued support, positive comments and prayers~
